

# Directions

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Kakuda High School

GRADE LEVEL: 1<sup>st</sup> year, middle level  
TIME: 1 -2 45 min periods depending on level  
SKILLS: Speaking, writing, listening  
MATERIALS: Hand-outs

OBJECTIVES: To learn new vocabulary and be able to give directions fluently using it.

## WARM-UP

1. Do listening warm-up 1 to check students know the difference between *turn left*, *turn right*, *it's on the left*, *it's on the right* and *go straight*.
2. Do warm-up 2 giving student A and B different mazes. Student A then closes their eyes and student B guides A though their maze. Student B then closes their eyes and student A guides them. After this exercise do group pronunciation of above vocabulary.
3. Using worksheet 1 ask students to match the Japanese and English through guess work and previous knowledge. Do group pronunciation afterwards.
4. Next test students retention of new vocabulary by matching pictures and words on worksheet 4.
5. Finally do a gap-fill activity to practice using directions vocabulary with sheet 4 and 5. Student A has the answers for student B and vice versa. They should both end up with the same map. The students should use new vocabulary learned from worksheets 1 and 2. Introduce block to help students give complete directions. Ask students to memorise the dialogue and give directions to each other.





